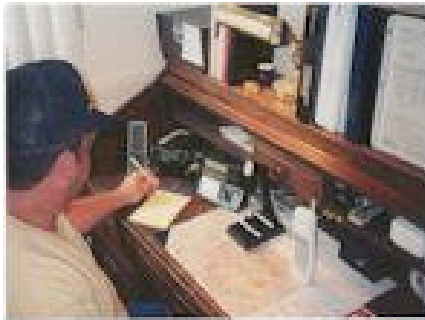

MONITORING

Crest members may listen to several kinds of radios—CB, GMRS, amateur or other. Because we have been trained in what we do, necessary information from motorists is passed by telephone to Highway Patrol or other police agency, Fire/Rescue, or Automobile Club. We may also supply directions or make telephone calls for their convenience and security.

REPORTING

If we observe anything important while driving, this is called to a monitor. Typical calls would be traffic accidents, fire and disabled vehicles. Several times we have been the first to report critical incidents such as an airplane crash and a hit-and-run driver. We can also notify traffic broadcasters at AM/FM stations on our UHF repeater system.

ASSISTING

Crest owns a trailer containing equipment necessary for "on-scene" operations and community events. Typical activities are communications for parades, races, air shows, Special Olympics, Toys for Tots, and marathons. In addition, we work closely with the American Red Cross. We have \$1,000,000 in liability insurance.
